<b>PIRANI Prosecco Extra Dry – Veneto, Italy</b> Textbook Prosecco; straw yellow, full of white peach elegance at just 11% abv.	7.00 / 25.00
<b>PIRINI Prosecco Rosato – Veneto, Italy</b> Soft pink prosecco with fruity and floral notes. Best served as an aperitif, ideal with delicate dishes.	28.00
<b>ROCHEMURE Cremant de Bourgogne – Burgundy, France</b> Fresh and yeasty bursting with apple fruit. Made with pronounced fruit which develops with time in the glass.	8.90 / 47.00
<b>NV VOIRIN JUMEL Brut Tradition – Champagne, France</b> Rare NV solely from grand cru fruit in Cramant. Akin to Bollinger with high Pinot content, yet with far finer fruit. Superb.	59.00
<b>NV DIEBOLT-VALLOIS Brut Prestige – Champagne, France</b> House pour at the George V in Paris no less and something seldom seen outside France's best hotels and restaurants. Blanc de Blancs from grand cru fruit.	95.00
<b>DIEBOLT-VALLOIS Fleur de Passion – Champagne, France</b> Their top cuvée from very old Chardonnay vines, raised Krug-like in old oak. A mature treat from 2005 vintage.	175.00
<b>MOET Dom Perigon – Champagne, France</b> Nose is highly perfumed bringing notes of white flowers, fresh citrus fruits, lemon, grapefruit with white peach and fresh yeasty dough coming through	259.00

<b>BACCICHETTO Chardonnay - Venezia Giulia, Italy</b> Intense, gently-oaked example full ripened apple and white peach. Finishes tropical and generous.	*6.00 / 7.00 / 8.00
<b>CANTINE VINCI Grillo – Sicily, Italy</b> Straw yellow with green flecks. Good mineral intensity and soft balance.	*6.50 / 8.00 / 9.50 / 25.50
<b>PINOT GRIGIO Friuli Grave 100% - I MAGREDI – DOC.</b> It has a bright straw yellow colour. On the nose intense aromas of delicate flowers. It presents itself with hints of pear, citrus and tropical fruits.	29.00
<b>CHATEAU DE BERZÉ Mâcon Milly–Lamartine – Burgundy, France</b> Beautiful clean and bright unoaked Chardonnay from one of the region's finest vineyards. Delicious and seriously good value.	30.00

<b>ROSELLO GAVI DI GAVI - Italy</b> Distinguished by its delicate aroma reminiscent of fresh fruit, it is pale yellow in colour with greenish hues, and dry flavour with underlying good acidity	38.00
<b>SOAVE CLASSICO BIXIO PODERI, 100% Garganega, Italy</b> Straw yellow with green hues. It is intense and fruity with notes of exotic fruits and ripe apricots. It is soft and complex with a prolonged finish.	39.00

Ripe, rich and easy red full of blueberry and blackberry made delicately spicy from a touch of oak.	
<b>MARQUES DE CACERES Excellens Cuvee Especial – Rioja, Spain</b>	*7.00 / 9.00 / 11.00 / 30.00
Modern take Tempranillo balancing ripe fruit and refined oak.	
<b>LUA NOVA LISBOA RED, Casa Santos Lima Winery- Portugal</b>	28.00
Intensely aromatic ripe black and fruits, juicy plums and dark berry with fine Tannins and a long lasting smooth finish. Vegetarian & Vegan Friendly	
<b>SAN GREGORIO Chianti DOCG – Tuscany, Italy</b>	29.50
Ruby red in color with red fruit, cherry and wild fruit aroma, it has a medium tannic structure with a long and persistent finish.	
<b>CHATEAU GABELOT Bordeaux – Bordeaux, France</b>	*7.50 / 9.50 / 11.50 / 32.50

De facto Fleurie from family vines going back to 1904! Outrageously good Beaujolais, full of floral, crunchy fruit. Such a bargain.	
<b>QUID PRO MALBEC MENDOZA – Argentina Benegas Winery</b>	36.00
Classic Argentinian Malbec from the Uco Valley in Mendoza. Elegantly Structured , rich, showing plummy fruit and hints of smoke and chocolate. Vegan & Vegetarian Friendly.	
<b>NEBBIOLO D'ALBA MASSUCCO – Italy</b>	39.00
Ruby red color, tending to garnet. Fruity perfume. Dry, velvety flavor	
<b>CASALE CILIANI Primitivo – Puglia, Italy</b>	44.00
Aromas of prunes licorice, vanilla and dried figs. Full bodied, opulent and velvety. A long finish with notes coffee and chocolate.	
<b>VILLA MONTEPALDI Chianti Classico 'Tagliafune' – Tuscany, Italy</b>	47.00
Reference point Chianti from an estate that dates back to 1101 AD. As good as Brunello this vintage with such beautiful balance.	
<b>TINTO PESQUERA Crianza – Ribera del Duero, Spain</b>	49.00
A touch firm at this stage but still an iconic classic – worth asking to be dicananted Expressive, deep, well-oaked version of great concentration.	
<b>PODERI BIXIO Amarone della Valpolicella – Veneto, Italy</b>	68.00
Ruby red with light garnet highlights. The bouquet is intense, with hints of red-fruit jam, black cherry that ends with vanilla.	
<b>MASSUCCO Barolo – Piedmont, Italy</b>	71.00
Nose is broad, intense and pleasantly complex; hints of ripe red fruits, spicy notes and expensive leather.	
<b>IL POGGIONE Brunello di Montalcino – Tuscany, Italy</b>	78.00
Perennial Parker favourite, whopping 97/100 points this vintage (2015) and a wine of supreme power and class. Try with our beef-rib main.	
<b>MOULIN DE DUHART Pauillac – Bordeaux, France</b>	85.00
Classic Pauillac from the esteemed Lafite-Rothschild stable. Perfectly mature being 2006 vintage.	
<b>J. VOILLOT Pommard 1er Cru Clos Micault – Burgundy, France</b>	99.00
Brightly fruited Pommard from the domaine's oldest vines, circa 1920. Silky and complex, a real treat.	
<b>HUBERT LIGNIER Gevrey Chambertin – Burgundy, France</b>	125.00
Gevrey's grand master and nothing short of magical tasted recently.	
<b>SASSICAIA Tenuta San Guido - Toscana, Italy</b>	390.00
Made with 85% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Cabernet Franc. Typical ruby red color and velvety tannins complemented by spice flavours and black currant aromas. Juicy here in 2013 with a taste of black fruit and a hint of mint freshness on the palate.
